

Guide For Bottle Entries.

All wine bottles shall have corks tied down, or plastic shrink caps for transit. Fill levels for competition entries are based on air space plus a tolerance.

Still wines	20 mm +/- 10 mm	Sparkling wines	70 mm +/- 10 mm
Liqueurs	20 mm +/- 10 mm	Beers	30 mm +/- 10 mm

Beer, Ale and Stout Entries

Clean standard brown glass bottles 750 ml (A B C type) bottles. Plain crown caps. Fill as shown below.

Wine Entries

Clean, clear colourless glass bottles, approximately 750 ml capacity. As illustrated below these must be with rounded, not sloping, shoulders, be straight necked and without screw type bottle top.

Liqueur Entries

Clean, clear colourless glass bottles, approximately 375 ml capacity and the same description as the 750 ml wine entries bottles.

Closures for Wine and Liqueur Entries

Only flanged corks as illustrated below are permissible. No flanged plastic stoppers to be used.

Sparkling Wine Entries

Clean conventional 750 ml sparkling wine bottles, with fully punted bottoms. Minimum empty weight of 800 gm, of any colour and without screw type bottle top. Stopper must be ribbed plastic (champagne type), held down with a wire cage.
